

Pharmaceutical Sciences Faculty Positions
Assistant, Associate, Full Professor

Outstanding candidates with expertise in pharmacogenomics / pharmacology / toxicology, medicinal chemistry, formulation / delivery, or other areas will be considered. The successful applicant is expected to have or to develop a vigorous, externally funded research program and to provide effective teaching in the PhD and PharmD programs.
